A Message from the Library

As the new Director of the Barberton Public Library, I am honored to serve you and to continue the tradition of excellent library service to the community. I am struck by the diversity and strength of our community and am excited by the continued impact the Library can have on transforming, improving and enriching the lives of residents.

2019 brought new community collaborations, services and programs including:

- More than 200 Born to Read Bags were delivered to the Maternity Ward at Summa Barberton Hospital.
- 242 children's outreach programs reached 11,482 students in preschool through middle school.
- Thanks to a collaboration with Barberton City Schools, BPL received a grant from the Barberton Community Foundation to purchase equipment to bring eSports to the Library.
- A new program called Craft Connections was introduced, offering creative, fun opportunities for individuals of all ages and abilities.
- In July, the first annual Potter Mania event was held followed by a Star Wars Celebration in December. Both events were well attended and enjoyed by all.

The Library ended 2019 with the continued dedication to be an integral part of the community where people of all ages can meet in a friendly, accessible, and comfortable environment.

As we look ahead, we will continue to develop new programs and services to meet the needs of our community.

A few new services you can expect to see in 2020:

- Grand opening of a Children's Makerspace
- Launch of an eSports Program


